All staff must recognise their role in modelling and teaching good behaviour.

However, all pupils are capable of understanding right and wrong and should be able to contribute positively to a safe and happy environment.

The school seeks to promote good behaviour under the banner of 'Set Your Sights High' and by using the following words:

Respectful

Safe

Successful

If all adults and young people seek to embody the above, it will follow that:

- Every pupil should feel safe, valued and respected, and be able to learn free from the disruption of others
- All pupils, staff and visitors are free from any form of discrimination
- Adults set an excellent example to pupils at all times
- Parents work in partnership with the school to support good behaviour of their son/daughter
- Fixed term exclusions are avoided wherever possible, but in a residential setting may need to be used to ensure that all pupils are safe.
