## OVERVIEW OF THE MODULE:

This 30 credit, Level 7 module enables students to:

- Develop the skills of research, enquiry, evaluation and data analysis in specialised contexts within the field of education of children who are deaf and/or educational audiology.
- Critically appraise research techniques and methodologies and to be able to select an appropriate methodology for the chosen topic.
- Successfully carry out and report upon a small scale research project in a relevant professional area.

## THIS WILL INVOLVE:

- Attendance at an introductory Study Weekend, at which students critically appraise research techniques and are supported to develop their research question and methodology.
- A designated specialist supervisor for up to 12 hours of individual support through the following year.
- Research opportunities within Mary Hare Schools, (subject to approval from the Mary Hare Research Committee).
- On-line resources via Studynet, (University of Hertfordshire Virtual Learning Environment).
- Completion of a research project and a 12,000 word dissertation.

## OPPORTUNITY FOR APL: (Accreditation of Prior Learning)

- Students with a PG Diploma in a relevant field obtained within the last 5 years have the opportunity to APL their existing credits to obtain an MA/MSc, (subject to application and approval by the University of Hertfordshire).
- Students with less current qualifications should discuss this in the first instance with the Programme Leader, Joy Rosenberg.

### COSTS:

- Full cost of module: £2,400.
- Cost of the Introductory Weekend: £400 including meals and accommodation. (This will be deducted from the cost of the overall module for those students who attend the weekend and then register for the module.
