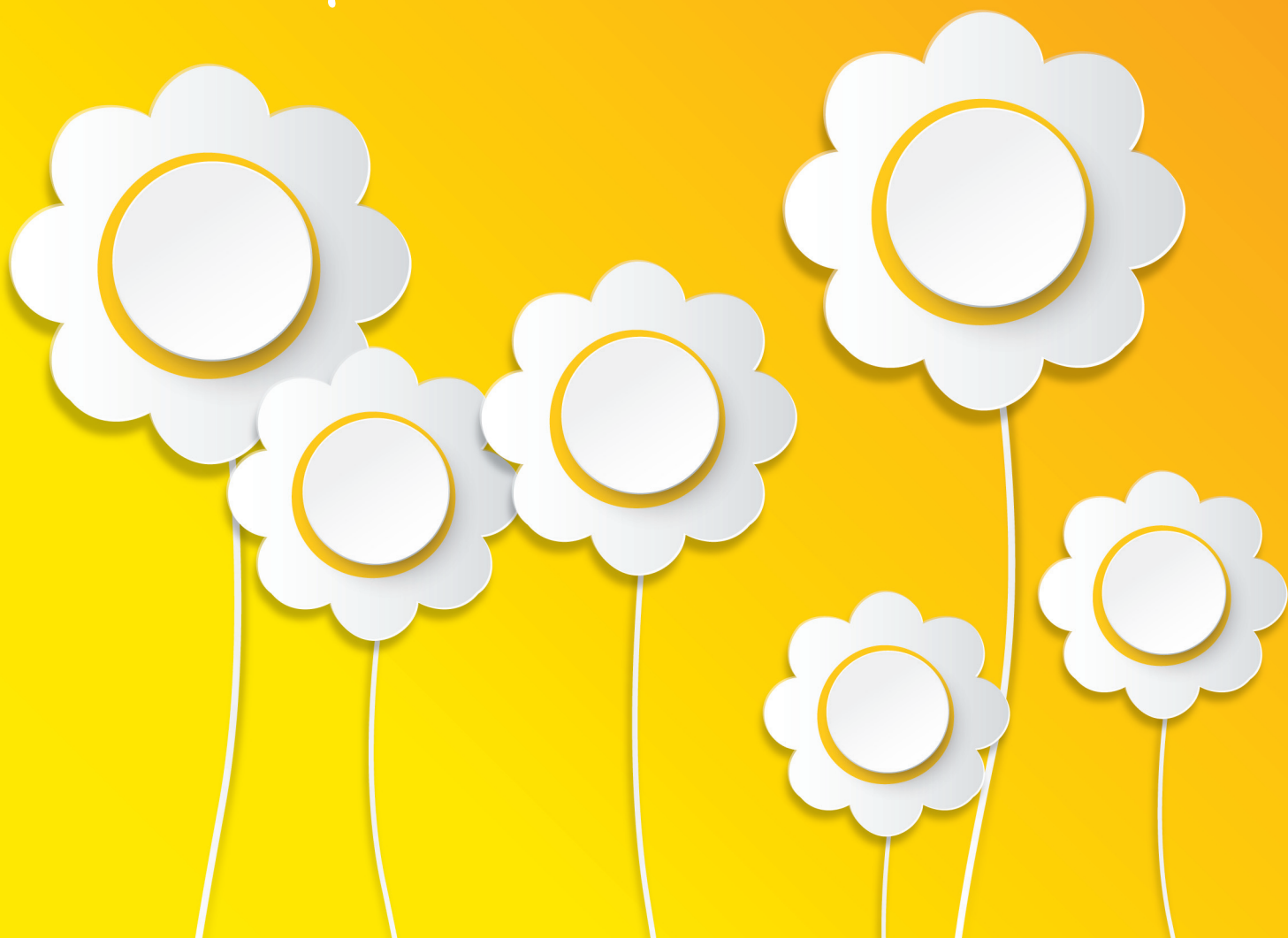

Clinical Ear Care Programme (CEC)

Delivered in partnership with Starkey Laboratories

Mary Hare offers a wide range of courses and training opportunities for anyone working in the field of deaf education or audiology, founded on more than 100 years of experience of working with profoundly deaf young people.

Elements of the course are BSA short course accredited and all aspects of the course are aimed to support the members of your team currently employed within the audiology sector and who wish to develop their clinical skills as an Audiology Assistant. Practical skills training is provided according to current BSA/BAA best practice guidelines. The programme is constructed as a work-based learning qualification where a portfolio is built on procedural tasks completed under the supervision of their work-based supervisor.



PRE-CLINICAL EAR CARE COURSE (PRE CEC)

This course is designed to provide an introduction to the skills required to remove wax safely and to carry out clinical ear care techniques as a hearing care professional. The course is intended for those students who will be working in a directly supervised environment, who may not have the experience of a Hearing Aid Dispenser etc, but who would like to extend their existing scope of practice such that they could then enrol in the full CEC course. After completion of this course, a graduate will be competent to remove wax under direct supervision using a logbook and future assessment on the full CEC course.

Students who attend the HCA course who also wish to attend the Clinical Ear Course will not be required to attend this pre-course.

CLINICAL EAR CARE PROGRAMME (CEC)

Wax removal techniques including instrumentation, irrigation, suction and video endoscopy will be trained during this two day programme. Following completion of this course, all graduates will be competent to manage the clinical ear care of any patient under their care. A logbook will be completed and assessed remotely for final certification.
